- 1. Any healthcare professional (surgeons, anesthesiologists, nutritionists, nurses) involved in surgical patient care is eligible to submit his/her/their research abstract.
- 2. An author may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts.
- 3. Papers must be original and unpublished. Papers that have been submitted in the past 12 months to other conferences may be submitted but updated.
- 4. The following must be fulfilled:
 - **TOPIC**: The research must focus on one or more elements of enhanced recovery programs/protocols or perioperative care/medicine. The following are some topics, but not limited to:
 - o Clinical elements
 - o Physiological effects and outcomes
 - o Health economics
 - o Implementation of ERAS
 - o Policy-making processes

- **DATA**: Only original data (including qualitative studies, systematic reviews, and meta analyses) must be submitted.

- o Must not be more than 250 characters (including spaces, symbols, and punctuations)
- o Abstract content must contain the following sections:
 - Title that clearly describes the nature of the paper
 - Name/s of author/s and institution/s (identify main author with asterisk (*)
 - Key aspects of the review of literature
 - Problem under investigation
 - Hypothesis
 - Methods used
 - Study results
 - Implications on ERAS
 - Conflict of Interest
 - Keywords
